Math Relays Events

Individual

Individual events will be conducted at the schools. Students take Math Relays tests using the Student Testing System (STS) in four competition categories: Algebra and Functions, Number and Quantity, Statistics and Probability, and Geometry. The individual Math Relays tests will be available in STS from Monday, February 6th through Friday February 24th. Each individual competition (test) lasts 15 minutes. Buildings should develop their own competition schedule to include as many students as possible.

Team

Team events will take place at Wyandotte High School on Sat. March 4, 2017. There are three types of team events: relay, medley, and team problem solving. In a relay, participants work problems individually and hand their solutions to a teammate, the "anchor". In a medley, participants work together to solve problems. In team problem solving a team works together to solve a single, challenging problem and then present their solution to a panel of judges. Relay and medley teams consist of 4 participants. Team problem solving teams consist of 6 participants.

Sigma

The Sigma event is a day long individual event on March 4th where high school students who have shown exceptional abilities in mathematics work challenging mathematics problems.



13th Annual Math Relays

This year, KCKPS will host its 13th annual Math Relays event, bringing together elementary, middle and high school students for a day of math problem solving that challenges their minds and advances their math skills. This year, we anticipate an estimated 1,200+ students to take part in the event.

In addition to the math competitions, students will have an opportunity to participate in a college and career fair. The idea is to link students to businesses and post-secondary schools that have a math component or focus.
