25% of students report NOT feeling safe at school

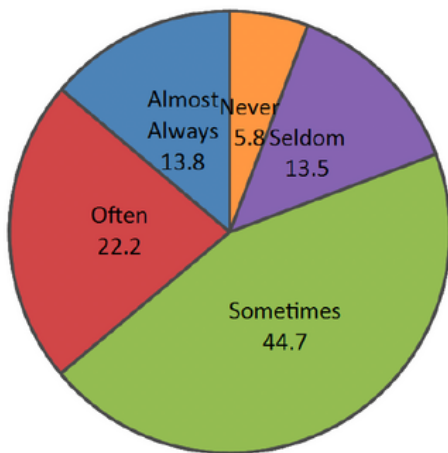
Data

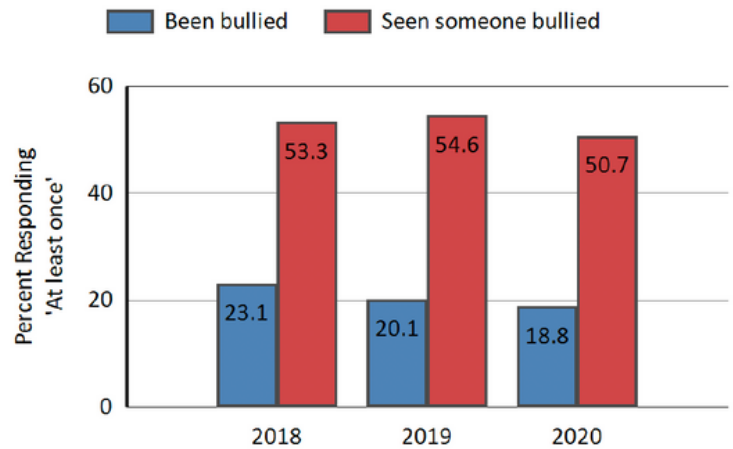
Programming
