Overview of the Competition

During the competition, elementary students will participate in a team problem-solving event. In a team problem-solving event, participants work together to solve a problem and then present their solution to a judge. Judging will take place in the following categories: Overall Presentation, Creativity, and Precision.

Logistics

For the team problem-solving event, participants work in teams of 6. Each elementary building will be able to send one fourth grade and one fifth grade team to the Relays; one coach will be required for the two elementary teams. Each building is budgeted for only one coach for both teams. This coach will be compensated through the district budget for up to 10 hours (includes hours for site coaching and the event). Transportation will be arranged and paid for by the district. Bus schedules will be shared once all sites/teams have been confirmed.
