This includes sharing what motivates you, your goals and aspirations, your strengths and opportunities for growth as a leader, as well as how you have impacted student achievement in your current role. You should also include what you are uniquely suited to bring to this founding cohort of future principals. The letters of recommendation must be from: current principal or supervisor, and a current colleague.
