

Teach Children to Save A Literacy-Based Program for K-3 Students

The Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City has partnered with local financial institutions and other organizations to share lessons with K – 3rd grade students in the Kansas City metropolitan area. Local volunteers are at the ready to visit classrooms this spring and limited space is still available.

Teach Children to Save shares the importance of saving and money management skills with K – 3rd grade students using children’s stories and activities. The program includes a 45-minute, literature-based lesson with hands-on activities and takeaways for each student. The lessons emphasize the concepts of decision-making, establishing savings goals, money recognition and math.

Teach Children to Save will be available between April 17 – 30, scheduled at a mutually beneficial date and time by the volunteer and teacher. No preparation or work is required on the teacher’s part and the volunteers will be trained and provide all necessary materials.
