ADVANCED RESTORATIVE PRACTICES: BEYOND TIER 1—REPAIRING HARM IN SCHOOLS

Many schools have begun implementing Tier 1 restorative practices (RP) as a foundation for positive school climate and community building. Successfully implementing restorative practices beyond this foundation and more directly in response to situations of harm and severe conflict (Tiers 2-3) requires a more advanced set of skills and implementation planning.

This interactive training will provide participants the opportunity to learn, build, and practice skills needed to facilitate problem-solving and harm-repair circles to address situations of severe conflict.

In this training, you will learn about or gain:

- ◆ *Applications of restorative practices for when severe harm/conflict damage relationships in a school community*
- ◆ *Skills to facilitate restorative conferences and harm-repair circles*
- ◆ *Implementation resources to continue broadening your school's restorative approaches at Tier 2-3 levels*



NOTE: This training assumes a foundational understanding of RP, and training in and practiced use of Tier 1 applications.
